| <b>SUMMARY OF KEY POINTS</b>   |  |
| <p>Minou Carey opened the meeting with salutations. Workgroup members introduced themselves. The agenda was reviewed and approved by all workgroup members that were present. Members reviewed meeting minutes from the May RxOTC Drug Abuse workgroup meeting. Ms. Carey noted changes to the attendance list that were identified by workgroup members. Without any further changes, present members approved the May RxOTC Drug Abuse workgroup meeting minutes. Ms. Carey provided a draft of the logic model to workgroup members. A discussion took place about the long-term goal of the RxOTC Drug Abuse workgroup logic model. The long-term outcome was changed from the following: Reduce the misuse and abuse of prescription drugs, to the following: <b>Reduce the misuse and abuse of prescription drugs with a focus on increasing community wellness</b>, as suggested by Larry Scott. Dianne Perukel and Pam Lynch volunteered to develop a draft of related objectives and activities, which will be included in the next draft of the logic model.</p> <p>A draft of the community scan survey was provided to workgroup members for review. Question number five (5) will be deleted from the survey. Elizabeth Agius of the State Epidemiological Outcomes Workgroup will review the questionnaire for content and suggestions. Once the questionnaire is approved, Ken Dail will have Kristine Norton create a link for dissemination. BSAAS will decide what agency will be responsible for disseminating the link. Due to security restrictions, Michigan State Police will disseminate the survey to law enforcement. Dominic Icobellis will provide a list of pharmacists for BSAAS to disseminate the survey to pharmacies.</p> <p>Pam Lynch provided a presentation on efforts to decrease unintentional overdose deaths by administering Naloxone, an opiate blocker promoted by the Lazarus program. Ms. Lynch provided an example of an overdose education pamphlet that can be used in combination with the injection information or as a stand alone educational tool for the public. Naloxone is doctor prescribed. Dr. Dillon raised concerns about ethical issues, as the Lazarus program provides the same treatment given in emergency rooms.</p> <p>Dianne Perukel provided an overview of the training programs for law enforcement officers on drugged driving. The basic class is the National Highway Traffic Safety Association's Standardized Field Sobriety Testing, which trains officers to identify and assess drivers suspected of being under the influence of alcohol. The next level is the Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement program, which provides officers with general knowledge related</p> |  |

to drug impairment. The most advanced level is the Drug Recognition Expert or Drug Recognition Evaluator, which trains officers to recognize impairment in drivers under the influence of drugs other than, or in addition to alcohol.

**NEXT STEPS**

1. Pam Lynch and Dianne Perukel will draft objectives and related activities for the next meeting.
2. Ken Dail will introduce Kristine Norton to Ms. Carey. Ms. Norton will format the survey.
3. Minou will send community scan questionnaire to Brenda for review by Elizabeth Agius.

**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS**

Brenda Stoneburner gave an update on the increase of benzodiazepines. More information is needed to determine the increase in abuse of this drug. Ms. Stoneburner also reported that poison control has reported more cases of K2/spice overdoses. Additional information on these two issues is forthcoming.
