### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

The primary responsibilities of this position are to provide Environmental Home Investigations (EI) for families with lead poisoned children located in Southeast Michigan, and to work with affected rental property owners to ensure lead-safe housing for occupants.

The position requires training for state certifications, self-study of state regulations, field work, and community and client-practitioner relations. The employee will be acting on behalf of the Michigan Department of Community Health in a capacity to ensure that EIs and follow-up activities are completed per Michigan lead laws and rules and in the best interests of the lead poisoned children.

### **SKILLS:**

Applied technical knowledge of the lead hazard identification and control industry obtained through training and employment. Ability to effectively communicate technical information, verbally and in writing. Ability to translate technical information into communications that the lay public can understand and take action on. Ability to collect, organize, and understand technical data effectively and accurately; and to formulate conclusions from the data. Experience working with families and lead industry professionals.

### **EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:**

Possession of a bachelor's degree in the physical sciences, biological sciences, environmental sciences, or engineering with a minimum of 30 term (20 semester) credits in any combination of these and/or related fields.

Must be currently certified as a Lead Inspector and Risk Assessor or must obtain Lead Inspection and Risk Assessor training (meeting prerequisites) and certification within 30 days of hire. Must pass Environmental Investigator certification within same time frame.
