1. A civil money penalty may be assessed for any Level 2 or higher deficiency, (see S.O.M. Section 7516) but should primarily be assessed for F-SQC or Harm deficiencies, and Level 2 deficiencies following removal of an IJ.
2. Facilities will not be given an opportunity to correct (daily CMP's will be imposed) when they have deficiencies of actual harm or above on a current survey and on the previous standard survey or any intervening survey; or they have two or more actual harm or SQC citations at the current survey.
3. The total civil money penalties assessed cannot exceed \$3,000 per day; or \$10,000 per instance.
4. To determine the CMP amount for continued noncompliance following an IJ removal, if the next highest citation is level two cite it is \$100.00 if it is a G or higher use the base amount.
5. Add money to the per day base penalty amount if the noncompliance is a repeat citation or same regulatory grouping at F-SQC, harm, or ANY IJ citation at the last survey.
 - \$50.00 - level F
 - \$100.00 - level G-I
 - \$150.00 - level J-L

6. Add money to the per day base penalty amount, based on the degree of culpability of the facility; i.e. if the noncompliance is intentional, or a product of neglect, indifference or disregard.
 - \$100.00 - \$250.00 - level F (SQC)
 - \$300.00 - \$1000.00 - level G - level I
 - \$1000.00 - \$2000.00 - level J - level L

7. Add money to the per day base amount for high numbers of citation at level F (SQC) or higher. (Remember don't include the highest level here)
 - 1-6 citations add \$50.00 for level G - level I, \$400.00 for level J - level L
 - 7-10 citations add \$100.00 for level G - level I, \$450.00 for level J-level L
 - 11-19 citations add \$150.00 for level G - level I, \$500.00 for level J - level L
 - 20 + citations add \$50.00 for level F, SQC, \$200.00 for G - level I, \$550.00 for level J - level L

THIS CIVIL MONEY PENALTY (CMP) SCHEDULE CONFORMS TO 42 CFR 488.408. THIS SCHEDULE IS INTENDED TO COVER THE MAJORITY OF CASES WHERE THE STATE AGENCY RECOMMENDS CMP IMPOSITION. SITUATIONS MAY ARISE THAT JUSTIFY DEPARTURE FROM THESE GUIDELINES.

Choose a per instance civil money penalty when one or more of the following factors are present.

- Findings of current/ongoing noncompliance that are isolated findings (singular event) of actual harm at Scope and Severity (S/S) of "G" or "J"
- Findings of current/ongoing noncompliance at a S/S of "G" or above, or Substandard Quality of Care (SQC) findings at a S/S of "F" where a facility has an opportunity to correct
- Findings of current/ongoing noncompliance at a S/S of "G" or above, or SQC findings at "F" but where a facility has a good compliance history; OR
- Findings of past noncompliance when dates of noncompliance CANNOT be determined at a S/S of "G" or above or SQC findings at a S/S of "F"
