

# Billing Tips for RHC/FQHC/THC/LPHD Providers

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## 1. Rural Health Clinics (RHC)

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For services to be included in the settlement, claims must be billed with the appropriate place of service (POS). For services provided at the RHC certified site must show a POS 72. Services provided at other locations should have the appropriate POS code noted in the Billing and Reimbursement for Professionals chapter of the Medicaid Provider Manual. The Group NPI number (Type 2 – Organization) must be used as the billing provider. The Provider NPI number (Type 1 – Individual) of the individual who performed the service or the supervising physician, should be entered as the rendering provider. For RHC claims, the Group NPI and Rendering NPI should never be the same. Also, the rendering NPI field should never be left blank.

## 2. Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC)

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For services to be included in the settlement, claims need to be billed with the appropriate place of service (POS). For services provided at the FQHC certified site must show a POS 50. Services provided at other locations should have the appropriate POS code noted in the Billing and Reimbursement for Professionals chapter of the Medicaid Provider Manual. The Group NPI number (Type 2 – Organization) must be used as the billing provider. The Provider NPI number (Type 1 – Individual) of the individual who performed the service or the supervising physician, should be entered as the rendering provider. For FQHC claims, the Group NPI and Rendering NPI should never be the same. Also, the rendering NPI field should never be left blank.

### **3. Tribal Health Centers (THC)**

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For services to be included in the settlement, claims need to be billed with the appropriate place of service (POS). For services provided at the THC certified site must show a POS 07. Services provided at other locations should have the appropriate POS code noted in the Billing and Reimbursement for Professionals chapter of the Medicaid Provider Manual. The Group NPI number (Type 2 – Organization) must be used as the billing provider. The Provider NPI number (Type 1 – Individual) of the individual who performed the service or the supervising physician, should be entered as the rendering provider. For THC claims, the Group NPI and Rendering NPI should never be the same. Also, the rendering NPI field should never be left blank.

### **4. Local Public Health Departments (LPHD)**

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For services to be included in the settlement, claims need to be billed with the appropriate place of service (POS) code noted in the Billing and Reimbursement for Professionals chapter of the Medicaid Provider Manual. The Group NPI number (Type 2 – Organization) must be used as the billing provider. The Provider NPI number (Type 1 – Individual) of the individual who performed the service or the supervising physician, should be entered as the rendering provider. For LPHD claims, the Group NPI and Rendering NPI should never be the same. Also, the rendering NPI field should never be left blank.
