Cogan stated that he has received many Inquires regarding whether manipulation under anesthesia is within the scope of chiropractic.

Cogan stated that it is a medical procedure under the direction, diagnosis and prescription of a medical doctor or osteopathic physician and that a chiropractor would be under the direction and employ of that physician and would perform manipulation and adjustment on a patient under anesthesia.

Discussion followed.

CHIROPRACTIC SCOPE BILL

Cogan stated that a bill to expand and restore the chiropractic scope of practice passed in the House but stalled in the lame duck session. The bill will now have to be re-introduced in the current session.
