- 2) Respondent shall submit quarterly employer reports.
- 3) Respondent shall provide to her mental health professional and employer copies of her administrative complaint dated January 25, 2006; Proposal for Decision dated November 20, 2008 and the Final Order granting reclassification.
- 4) During Respondent's probationary period, Respondent's mental health treatment provider shall submit evidence to the Department regarding Respondent's completion of treatment.


