COMMITTEE REPORTS

Allegation Review Committee

Hennessy reported that for the month of February, the Committee reviewed 30 files, of which 13 were authorized for investigation, 10 were closed and 7 were returned for additional information. She indicated that 33 files will be reviewed today.

Professional Behavior Committee

Wyche indicated that the Committee has reviewed language contained on the AADE website regarding unprofessional contact as it relates to sexual boundaries. The Allegation Review Committee will be reviewing this language as well.

Anesthesia Committee

No report.

Continuing Education Committee

Hodder indicated that the Committee is still reviewing the issue of allowing CE credits to be earned for volunteer activities and is currently reviewing information provided to the Committee by the Department. Discussion will continue at their next meeting.

Endorsement Committee

Marinelli stated that Marie Allston, RDH, petitioned for licensure. However, the request was denied as Ms. Allston needs to take the State of Michigan nitrous and local anesthesia tests.

RDA Committee

Buchheister stated that the RDA and RDH Committees met together prior to today's meeting. Discussion regarding PA161 are continuing and this matter shall be referred to the Parameters Committee for further discussion.

RDH Committee

Hodder indicated that the RDH Committee met today with the RDA Committee to continue discussions regarding delegating duties to RDA's.

Rules Committee

Swiger reported that the Committee discussed draft 13 at today's subcommittee meeting. It is the Committee's hope to present a final draft at the June meeting.

Parameters of the Practice of Dentistry Special Committee

Marinelli directed the Board to the proposed statement which was provided by the Department. Board discussion was held and possible changes were addressed. AAG Wagner-Gutkowski indicated that the statement has not yet been reviewed by the Attorney General's office, but it is her intention to have the review completed by the June meeting.

Sanction Monitoring Committee

No report.

Chairperson's Report

Hennessy provided the Board with information pertaining to tooth bleaching agents. She discussed that there are other states that require this procedure to be done by a dentist. She would like the Board of Dentistry to issue a position statement on this topic. Discussion was held and a committee including Snow, Manos, Swiger and Bera will create a proposed statement and report back to the Board.

NEW BUSINESS

ADEX Update

Marinelli reported that there are some states that no longer accept the ADEX exam because of a disagreement with the hygiene portion of the exam. Beginning June, 2009, CREDTS will no longer administer the ADEX. This issue is scheduled to be discussed at the upcoming NERB meeting in June. Marinelli will provide updated information to the Board at the June Board meeting.

AADE Update

Hennessy indicated that the AADE is accepting nominations for the citizen of the year award. This award will be given at the annual meeting in September 2009.

Radiography Curriculum Guidelines

Buchheister directed the Board to the handout entitled "Guidelines for Evaluating Radiograph Curriculum and Instruction for the 'Substantially Equivalent' Dental Assisting Radiology Program."

MOTION by Swiger, seconded by Wyche, to accept the Guidelines as presented.

Discussion was held and various changes were noted. The motion was withdrawn. The RDA Committee will address the suggested changes and provide an updated version to the Board at the June meeting.

Additionally, the issue of delegation of duties to RDA's in a PA 161 setting has been transferred to the Parameters Committee.

MOTION by Marinelli, seconded by Wyche, to grant Petitioner a limited license for a minimum period of 18 months in the matter of Surabhi Desai, DDS. Petitioner will be placed on probation to run concurrent with the period of limitation. Petitioner must practice under Board-approved, direct on-site supervision. Petitioner must submit quarterly supervisor reports to the Department. A Board member will perform a minimum of three (3) random, unannounced on-site reviews and the Board member will be granted the ability to communicate with any individual in Petitioner's office and have the opportunity to review office protocol. It will be the Board member's discretion to continue the random, unannounced visits beyond the required three (3). Petitioner shall not perform direct billing. In the event Petitioner must perform billing activities, she must do so via a third party. Petitioner must complete a minimum of eight (8) live hours of continuing education in the area of risk management, which shall not count towards requirements for license renewal. Upon completing the above terms, petitioner must petition for reclassification of her license.

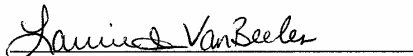
