Respondent shall bring at least 10-15 patient records as they pertain to the dental disciplines of prosthetics, crown and bridges, implants, restorative, periodontal therapy, and endodontic treatments. The records shall be in compliance with the Administrative Rules and shall include written records, radiographs, pertinent laboratory materials, casts, slips, and any correspondence to a referral doctor. The patient records shall be on patients that Respondent has personally treated and shall include the procedures involving endodontics, periodontal therapy and fixed prosthetics.
- 2) Within 6 months, Respondent shall complete continuing education courses on the following topics:
 - a) Endodontics: to be at least a 2 day, hands-on course that includes lecture and participation;
 - b) Fixed Prosthetics: to be a 2 day, hands-on course that includes proper diagnosis and preparation procedures, and shall also include lecture and participation;
 - c) Diagnosis: to be at least an 8 hour course to include radiographic interpretation as it pertains to treatment plans;
 - d) Periodontics: to be at least an 8 hour course to include proper treatment of involved dentition as it pertains to treatment plans and the prognosis of the involved teeth;
 - e) Risk Management: to be a 1/2 half day course to cover, but not be limited to, the delegation of duties of auxiliary duties.

The above-reference continuing education courses must be pre-approved by the DSC Chairperson or her designee no later than 60 days prior to the date of the course.

- 3) Respondent must take and successfully pass the JERM examination administered by the Northeast Regional Board of Dental Examiners.

Respondent shall be discharged from probation after successful completion of his continuing education and monitoring requirements.

Discussion followed.

The patient records shall be on patients that Respondent has personally treated and shall include the procedures involving endodontics, periodontal therapy and fixed prosthetics.
- 2) Within 1 year, Respondent shall complete continuing education courses on the following topics:
 - a) Endodontics: to be at least a 2 day, hands-on course that includes lecture and participation;
 - b) Fixed Prosthetics: to be a 2 day, hands-on course that includes proper diagnosis and preparation procedures, and shall also include lecture and participation;
 - c) Diagnosis: to be at least an 8 hour course to include radiographic interpretation as it pertains to treatment plans;
 - d) Periodontics: to be at least an 8 hour course to include proper treatment of involved dentition as it pertains to treatment plans and the prognosis of the involved teeth;
 - e) Risk Management: to be a 1/2 day course to cover, but not be limited to, the delegation of duties of auxiliary duties.

The above-referenced continuing education courses must be pre-approved by the Board Chairperson or her designee no later than 60 days prior to the date of the course.

- 3) Respondent must take and successfully pass the JERM examination administered by the Northeast Regional Board of Dental Examiners.

Respondent shall be discharged from probation after successful completion of his continuing education and monitoring requirements.




