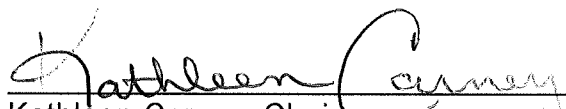
ANNOUNCEMENTS

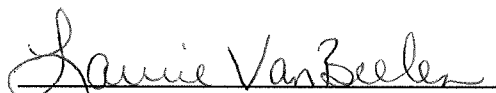

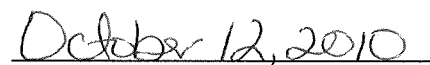
