Respondent's license shall be automatically reinstated if he provides proof to the Department that he holds a full and unencumbered license in Arizona and provides proof that he has entered into and is complying with an HPRP disciplinary monitoring agreement. If Respondent's license is reinstated, he shall be placed on probation for a period of one (1) year and shall comply with the Public Health Code. If Respondent's license is suspended for more than six (6) months, he must apply for reinstatement.

These continuing education hours shall not count towards credits required for licensure renewal.

If Respondent's license is suspended for more than six (6) months, he must reapply for reinstatement. Additionally, a fine in the amount of \$500 is imposed which shall be paid prior to reinstatement.






