## **HEALTH PROFESSIONAL RECOVERY COMMITTEE PRESENTATION**

Charles Newman, R.Ph., Chairperson of the Health Professional Recovery Committee (HPRC), introduced himself to the Board and provided a verbal report highlighting the background and duties of the Health Professional Recovery Program (HPRP). Newman shared that the Board of Pharmacy was one of the original boards that were instrumental in the formation of the HPRP. Newman also explained the path that licensees typically follow when involved with the program and gave examples of what the obligations of an HPRP contract would include. The Board was provided with the 2007-2008 Annual Statistical Report for the HPRP and Newman answered various questions from Board members.
