PUBLIC COMMENT

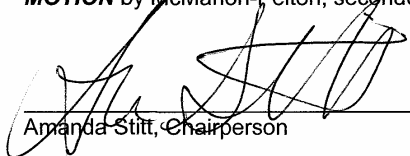
Liebler stated that he felt if an Administrative Law Judge makes a decision on a case that should be the final outcome. He does not think a judge's decision should be disagreed with.
