Actions to combine these agencies for certain reports have not yet been completed. Information for these agencies is therefore reported separately for the time frame covered by this report. In FY 2010-11, Department of Energy, Labor and Economic Growth was renamed the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs by Executive Order 2011-4, effective April 25, 2011.
