In FY 2010-11, the Department of Energy, Labor and Economic Growth was renamed the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs by Executive Order 2011-4, effective April 25, 2011. In FY 2010-11, the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) was transferred by Executive Order 2011-4 from the Department of Treasury to Strategic Fund, effective April 25, 2011. Actions to combine these agencies for reporting purposes were not completed until October 2, 2011. Information for these agencies is now combined for the time frame covered by this report. In FY 2010-11, the Department of Agriculture was renamed the Department of Agriculture and Rural Development by Executive Order 2011-2, effective March 13, 2011.
