In FY 2010-2011, the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) was transferred by Executive Order 2011-4 from the Department of Treasury to Strategic Fund, effective April 25, 2011. Actions to combine these agencies for reporting purposes were not completed until October 2, 2011. Information for these agencies is now combined for the time frame covered by this report.
