Currently, these positions represent 83.1 percent of all noncareer appointments. For this report, the number of employees who Job Share are halved. Job Share positions are those occupied by two or more individuals scheduled to share a job by performing the duties which would normally be assigned to a single employee. In FY 2014-15, the Department of Talent and Economic Development was established by Executive Order 2014-12, effective February 17, 2015.
