What Kind of Positions Are Available?

Registered Nurse P11 (\$21.28 - \$28.11)

The P11-level does not require a specific type or amount of experience.

The P11-level nurses perform a broad range of nursing duties.

Registered Nurse 12 (\$22.93 - \$30.17)

The 12-level requires one (1) or more years of experience equivalent to a RN P11.

The 12-level function as a senior worker or as an emergency/clinic nursing services specialist.

Some jobs may qualify for shift differential pay and/or prison pay of \$0.40 to \$0.50 per hour.
