What is the MiPHY?

The MiPHY is a new Web-based, anonymous student survey offered collaboratively by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE) and the Michigan Department of Community Health (MDCH) at no cost to districts. Beginning in 2007-2008, the MiPHY will be offered to all Michigan schools biennially to assess risk behaviors, risk factors and protective factors associated with alcohol, tobacco, other drug use, and violence in Grades 7, 9, and 11.
