The Fiscal Year 2017 School Aid Budget, through Section 11o(2) of PA 249 of 2016, provides \$8.3 million to Genesee Intermediate School District (ISD) for state early intervention services provided to children less than five years of age as of September 1, 2015 and that are similar to the services described in the *Early On* Michigan state plan.

3. Background/Purpose of Grant Program:

A state declaration of emergency was proclaimed by Governor Snyder on January 5, 2016 for the city of Flint and Genesee County due to lead contamination of the water supply. General funds were provided to the School District of the City of Flint and Genesee Intermediate School District (ISD) on January 29, 2016 with passage of Public Act 3 of 2016. Additional funding for fiscal years 2016 and 2017 has been appropriated in the state school aid act and MDE's budget. Several grants will be issued for the purpose of caring for children who are or may have been impacted by lead contamination. In addition, funds have been appropriated in the MDE budget for the purpose of expanding access to fresh fruits and vegetables.
