**SUBJECT:** 2016-17 Final Allocations Available in the Consolidated Application

The 2016-17 final allocations are posted on the Office of Field Services (OFS) website's [Program Allocations](#) page under **Tools & Resources** and are available in the 2016-17 Consolidated Application in MEGS+ for all programs.

The deadline is **January 15, 2017** to apply for the following grants in order to receive a July 1, 2016 obligation date or the obligation date established for your Local Educational Agency's (LEA's) 2016-17 Consolidated Application:

- Title I, Part D – Neglected or Delinquent Prevention/Intervention
- Title III, Part A – Immigrant Students Program
- Title III, Part A – Limited English Proficient Students Program
- Title VI, Part B, Subpart 2 – Rural and Low-Income Grant

If the status of your LEA's 2016-17 Consolidated Application is "Application In Progress," complete the application and submit it as soon as possible to establish a date to obligate funds for 2016-17 program activities.

If the status of your LEA's 2016-17 Consolidated Application is "Application Submitted," "Modifications Submitted," or "Review In Progress," please communicate with your OFS Regional Education Consultant to determine the timeline for approval.

If the status of your LEA's 2016-17 Consolidated Application is "Modifications Required" or "Modifications In Progress," budget all available grant funds and

If your LEA's 2016-17 Consolidated Application is in "Grant Funds Available" status, initiate an amendment when you are ready to apply for the final allocations and 2015-16 carryover funds, if applicable. The deadline to submit an amendment to your LEA's 2016-17 Consolidated Application is January 15, 2017. **Please note:** the 2015-16 Final Expenditure Reports (FERs) must be certified in the Cash Management System (CMS) before available carryover will appear in the Consolidated Application Budget Summary screens. The due date for 2015-16 FERs is **November 29, 2016**.

If your LEA will exceed the 15% carryover limitation and is eligible to request a waiver, please submit a [Title I, Part A 15% Carryover Waiver Request for 2015-16 Funds](#) which is posted on the OFS website under **Current Topics**. The deadline to submit a wavier is **December 1, 2016**.

When applying for your LEA's Title I, Part A final allocation and available Title I, Part A carryover funds, if applicable, please remember to amend the 2016-17 Title I School Selection Application to reflect any changes in available funds. If your LEA's Title I School Selection Application is not in "Plan Approved" status, you may need to contact your OFS Regional Education Consultant to have the application returned for modifications.

If your LEA is not going to apply for 2016-17 allocations for one or more of these programs, please complete the [Request to Relinquish Funds Form](#) posted on the OFS website under **Current Topics** and submit it per the instructions on the top of the form by **November 30, 2016**, to allow these funds to be reallocated to other eligible LEAs.
