This grant supports the mission of the State Board of Education by providing funding so all students graduate ready for careers, college, and community.

This grant is consistent with the Michigan Department of Education's Priority 1: Close achievement gaps in reading and math, with an initial focus on African-American young men for whom data show are Michigan's persistently lowest achieving student group.

PURPOSE / BACKGROUND OF GRANT

The State School Aid Act provides \$340,000 for the purpose of a pre-college engineering K-12 education program that is focused on the development of a diverse future Michigan workforce, that serves multiple communities within southeast Michigan, that enrolls pupils from multiple districts, and that received funds appropriated for this purpose in the appropriations act that provided the Michigan strategic fund budget for 2014-2015.

The program must have the ability to expose pupils to, and motivate and prepare pupils for science, technology, engineering, and mathematic careers and postsecondary education with special attention given to groups of pupils who are at-risk and underrepresented in technical professions and careers.

The Detroit Area Pre-college Engineering Program is eligible for a single grant of up to \$340,000.

The target population is students in southeast Michigan, focusing on groups who are at-risk and underrepresented in technical professions and careers.
