Student Roster

Note: The Early Literacy and Mathematics fall benchmark test occurs before the official collection of MSDS data. This means that demographic data such as Student Population, English learner (EL), Students with Disabilities (SWD), and Grade Level will not display a student's current status if data has not been entered in MSDS or their status has changed since last year.

The Early Literacy and Mathematics Benchmark Assessment Student Roster allows users to view student Points Earned out of Max Points possible by grade, content, domains and categories.

If the school has chosen to assign reporting codes (formerly known as Class/Group Codes) to students, then students may be filtered on the available reporting codes. In addition, the population of students to be displayed may be selected by the user. Users may select from the following student populations:

1. All Students - this is the default
2. Students with Disabilities - students who are marked Special Education in the Michigan Student Data System (MSDS) at the time of testing
3. All Except Students with Disabilities - students who are not marked Special Education in MSDS at the time of testing
4. Reporting Codes – schools that identified reporting codes for groups of students can filter according to assigned reporting codes.

The report is divided into two main sections:

1. An alphabetical listing of the selected students.
2. Points Earned by domain and assessment category in a table format.

Selected Students:

Students in the selected population are displayed in ascending alphabetical order by last name, then first name. The sort sequence may be changed to sort in descending alphabetical order. The following data is displayed in the hover icon :

1. Date of Birth (DOB)
2. Unique Identification Code (UIC)
3. Gender
4. SWD

5. EL
6. Ethnicity
7. Designated Support (DS)
8. The hover icon will display as,  indicating there was an issue that flagged this student's test as invalid. Review scores carefully. The hover will display the reason such as Tested in Incorrect Grade and Prohibited Behavior. The scores for the student will still be displayed.

Overall Content Performance (Table Format)

For each selected student, Points Earned by assessment category, domain subtotal and overall content total are displayed. Points Earned by domain subtotal and overall content total are sortable. The table below shows the domains for each content area.
