## Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP Tests for All Grades




### State Average


**Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades**

**Percentage of 8th Graders Proficient on MEAP**




## Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades


## Student Progress from 2007-2008 MEAP tests for All Grades




**Average MME Scale Scores 2009**
