

WHAT DO I DO?

Write the district level reform and redesign plan elements.

Assign a central office authority to partner with building leadership to collectively assume responsibility for the building's turnaround efforts.

Implement mission critical interventions to support building's turnaround efforts.

Call union and board leadership.

Address primary areas of concern to increase district readiness.

Establish the collective need to address systemic issues that hinder a priority building's likelihood for rapid turnaround.
