The Michigan Department of Education will conduct a planned review of standards, expectations, and alignment with state assessments in each content area as indicated in the Review Cycle in the chart below. During the review process, teams will review common core or national standards, recommendations from National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), National Assessment Governing Board (NAGB), and professional organizations, and make recommendations for possible revision of state standards and expectations. Determinations of the scope of the review and revision will be made by MDE prior to beginning each study.

The cycle defines the planned timeline for revision based on current adoption and implementation.
