The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) is pleased to announce the 2006-2007 State School Aid Act Section 99(6) Mathematics and Science Centers Curriculum and Professional Development Support for the Michigan Merit Curriculum. \$1,000,000 is available for this initiative. This is a competitive grant program targeted to Michigan Intermediate School Districts (ISDs).

A single grant of \$1,000,000 will be made to an Intermediate School District (ISD) to work in partnership with the Mathematics/Science Centers for the purpose of providing curriculum and professional development support to assist districts in implementing the Michigan Merit Curriculum components for mathematics and science.

Grant applications must be submitted to MDE by mail. Applications must be postmarked no later than December 22, 2006.
