Appeal of AMAO Status

After reviewing the districts AMAO status, if you believe that the calculations used by the Office of Educational Assessment and Accountability (OEAA) are incorrect, districts can submit an appeal to OEAA@michigan.gov. Appeals will not be handled over the phone.

You must include the following information when submitting your appeal:

- In the subject line of the email type "AMAO Appeal"
- Districts name and number
- Name of district contact person, phone number and email address
- Which AMAO are you appealing (I, II or III)
- Data upon which you are basing your appeal
- Special issues/concerns pertinent to your appeal

All demographic corrections such as a student's Limited English Proficiency (LEP) status must be corrected in the Michigan Student Data System (MSDS) by your designated person before an appeal can be filed with OEAA.

All appeals must be received at oeaa@michigan.gov by **Friday, October 1, 2010 at 5:00 p.m.**
