AWAKE CLC provides a supplemental tutoring program to students at-risk of educational failure. The instructional program is based upon the Continuous Improvement Model. The CIM approach tracks student performance and helps to close the achievement gap. The CIM measures individual student needs through end of unit diagnostic assessments. The assessments have been developed through The Focus on MEAP Grade Level GLCEs Book and Houghton Mifflin Skills Tutor which is our web based component. AWAKE will develop an Individualized Learning Plan of the concepts and skills needed by each individual student. To help student reach ILP goals the instructional program offers one to one, small groups, and web-based instruction in 2 hour blocks 3 days per week. Progress Reports are given bi-weekly. AWAKE CLC employs site directors and tutors that are teachers certified by the State of Michigan and highly qualified in their area of certification.
