Kindergartens thru 12th graders enrolled in the AATS program are taught reading, writing and mathematics lessons that complement their school's curriculum. These lessons, which includes strategies for special education and ELL students focus on state content standards. Each student is given a pretest to diagnose his/her instructional level. An individual educational plan is written based on that diagnosis and discussed with the student's parent and teacher. At the end of the tutoring program the student is given a posttest to evaluate his/her level of achievement. The AATS tutors are certified teachers and degreed professionals. All tutors are trained by educational consultants on the research-based AATS program. The two hour sessions are held two - four times weekly, after school, on weekends and during the summer. The sites include student's home, school, library, church and community center. Parents and teachers receive written quarterly reports from the tutors.
