All students receive pretesting prior to program implementation to assess student strengths and weaknesses. The goals set for each student will be set in accordance with the results from the pretest. The student/teacher ratio is 1:5, and tutoring locations include churches, local LEA's, as well as in-home. Academic Alliance LLC employs qualified tutors from within and outside the LEA.
