How Achieving 180,LLC Explains Their Tutoring Program, in Their Own Words:

Achieving 180, LLC uses the diagnostic/prescriptive model of instruction. The program used, based on mastery learning, has a consistent record of assisting targeted students to improve in reading and mathematics an average of two (2) grade levels. The staff will assess the skill levels of each student, using standardized assessments. This information will be used to construct the student's learning plan. The tutoring groups consist of 1-8 students. All instructional materials and classroom supplies are provided as a part of the service. Sessions during the week are on two days and last two hours. Saturday sessions run four hours. The program consists of programmed instruction that provides students with instructional materials that allow them to move at their own pace. The instructional staff will be current or retired certified teachers. Highly qualified persons may also be used, under the supervision of certified teachers, on a 1:1 ratio.
