FAME Vision

To provide job-embedded professional development for MI educators to learn about, implement, and reflect upon the formative assessment process in classrooms.

FAME

- Uses a learning team model with a facilitator (coach)



- Team operates on learning process, selecting and using strategies and tools that teachers and students apply as part of daily practice

Good News

- Commitment of funding for our 4th cohort of new coaches and learning teams
- Continuing relationship with Measured Progress
- All training dates and locations are secured for 2011-12
- Formal development of Regional Coach role

Challenges

- Thousands of educators to reach
- Continuing demands on teachers and administrators
- Limited resources
- Scaling within MI and within buildings and districts

Administrator Considerations

- Clear vision of implementation goals
- Ability to support learning teams (new and continuing)
- Teacher leader becomes coach for learning team of 6-8 members
- Existing learning team member(s) become coaches of new learning teams
- Administration participation




