The Ministry and Community Center of Burton, Mich., provides results-oriented afterschool tutoring in the areas of mathematics and English language arts to middle and high school students in grades 7-12. Our main goal is to help students who are not currently performing at grade level to enhance their educational performance by engaging them in small group (5:1 student/instructor ratio) after school, computer-based, tutoring sessions with caring and motivated certified teachers, college graduates and highly qualified graduate students. To increase success, students attend two-hour tutoring sessions three times per week. Passport Reading Journeys and Inside Algebra, two nationally recognized, research-based strategic intervention programs aligned with state of Michigan benchmarks, are used to engage students effectively and promote success. To make sure each student is receiving the best instruction possible, placement tests, pre and post-tests, and regular assessments are administered. Parent participation is encouraged, flexible schedules can be arranged, and free transportation is provided.
