

SUBJECT: Application for Funding and Formal Agreement for Title I, Part D, Subpart 2 Programs 2013-14 Grant Cycle

The Michigan Department of Education (MDE) Office of Field Services (OFS) is pleased to announce the availability of the newly combined "Application for Funding/Formal Agreement" for Title I, Part D federal funding for Local Educational Agencies (LEAs) for the new grant cycle covering the 2013-14 school year. Please note that Title I, Part D funds are allocated to eligible facilities and are administered by the Fiscal Agents.

The "Application for Funding/Formal Agreement" for Federal Funding (Title I, Part D) must be completed in a joint effort between the Fiscal Agent, Service Provider and Facility. It must then be uploaded to the Fiscal Agent's 2013-14 Consolidated Application in the Michigan Electronic Grants System *Plus* (MEGS+) as an attachment using the "Additional Budget Detail Information" link. The deadline for submission of the "Application for Funding/Formal Agreement" is the same date the 2013-14 Consolidated Application is submitted in MEGS+. This action, along with marking "Apply Later" in the "Review Grant Selections" screen, provides the Fiscal Agent with an obligation date for Title I, Part D funds. When OFS notifies LEAs of their 2013-14 Title I, Part D allocations they must apply for their allocation and carryover funds, if applicable, by January 15, 2014, to maintain their obligation date.
