The FY 2011-2012 Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) Comprehensive Community Needs and Resources Assessment (CNRA) preapplication is available through the Michigan Electronic Grants System (MEGS) website:

School districts/public school academies (PSAs) that do not submit a CNRA on or before the due date may not receive GSRP funding for FY 2011-2012.

School districts/PSAs that qualify and apply under Sections 32d and 39 of the State School Aid Act may receive funds to operate a GSRP. The FY 2011-2012 GSRP application will also be available through MEGS. Superintendents and PSA directors will be notified of the application due date.
