In light of the MI Safe School: Michigan's 2020-21 Return to School Roadmap, as outlined in Executive Order 2020-142, the Office of Career and Technical Education (OCTE) is providing Career and Technical Education (CTE) Roadmap: Return to Learn Guidance. Local education agencies (LEAs), both traditional public school districts and public school academies, that operate state-approved career and technical education programs should work with their career education planning district (CEPD) director to design instructional plans.
