## ***How Class Act Education and Music Explains Their Tutoring Program, in Their Own Words:***

Class Act Education & Music After-School Program, henceforth CA-M, combines mathematics, language arts and science tutoring services with music along with mentoring. This program's focus is to motivate the music-minded student to achieve academically. The curriculum CA-M uses Study Island, a web based skills mastery software for grades k – 12. Sessions are either individual, one on one service and/or group sessions of 5 to 1. The Study Island program/curriculum has proven success and impact on Michigan assessments and educational benchmarks. Within the CA-M Program students must complete at least four (4) hours of tutoring to participate in weekend music workshop. Points are accumulated weekly by attendance, performance, behavior, and enthusiasm. Volunteer local music personalities to include local music executives, artists, and radio personalities will facilitate the weekend workshops. Workshops will be 1-2 hrs long where students will have the opportunity to share and learn about the music industry. CA-M embraces the idea of linking together academics, music and mentoring to provide well rounded academic success.
