

**Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP)  
Michigan Student Data System (MSDS) Early Childhood Related Fields  
August 2011**

The following table includes descriptions of required MSDS fields for GSRP grantees. Enter information on children funded by the GSRP for each MSDS Early Childhood field. There are also other required MSDS components, such as homeless, limited English proficient or eligible for supplemental nutrition.

It is recommended that the entity providing GSRP submit MSDS data. An entity submitting on behalf of another entity must complete and submit a signed security agreement.

<b>Fiscal Entity Type As indicated in EEM</b>	A	GSRP report Code D

<b>Fiscal Entity Code</b>	Numeric Text	Enter the five-digit fiscal entity code for the administrating intermediate school district (ISD).
<b>School Facility Number</b>	Numeric Text (can have leading zeros)	Report the educational building where the GSRP-enrolled child participates in the classroom-based program. This will typically be a school building within a district.  Formula and competitive programs may report a school facility outside of the child's district of residence.  Subcontracted programs may leave this field blank if the child does not receive services in a school building.  Competitive programs not providing services within a school building must leave this item blank.
<b>Early Childhood Program</b>	01	Great Start Readiness Program
<b>Early Childhood Program Start Date</b>	Date Only	Enter the date the child first received services with this program, e.g., the first day of classroom programming.
<b>Early Childhood Program End Date</b>	Date Only	Enter the date the child last received services with this program, and exited the program.
<b>Early Childhood Exit/Reason</b>	063	Program Completed
	064	Parent Initiated Transfer
	065	Program Initiated Transfer (e.g., special education referral)

	066	Child's Behavior does not meet expectations (e.g., expulsion). Note: this field is rarely used in GSRP. For a child enrolled in GSRP, severe and challenging behaviors require involvement of a mental health professional.
	067	Parent Withdrew Child (e.g., move from district, no information on subsequent program, etc.)
	068	Death of Child
	069	Program Termination (e.g., license expired, lack of enrollment, insufficient funds, staffing issues, building condemned, etc.)
	999	Other Reason or Reason Unknown/Undetermined
<b>Early Childhood Delivery Method</b>	1	GSRP is provided predominately within a facility identified in EEM as a school.
	2	GSRP is provided in a facility identified in EEM as a Unique Educational Program (UEP) or Other Non-School Recipient (ONSR) or not listed in EEM.
	3	GSRP is predominately provided within the child's home.
