RE: Grant Opportunity for Early Childhood Education and Family Services

The Michigan Department of Education is pleased to announce a **William F. Goodling Even Start Family Literacy Program** grant opportunity. The goal of the William F. Goodling Even Start Family Literacy Program is to develop demonstration projects that focus on providing intensive family literacy services. These funds are geared toward improving the literacy skills of parents, helping them become full partners in educating their children, and assisting children to reach their full potential as learners. Program models must include adult education, early childhood education, parent education and parent-child educational activities. A local or intermediate school district or a public school academy joined in partnership with a public or private nonprofit, community-based agency or institution of higher education may apply for a grant. It is anticipated that funds totaling approximately \$2.3 million will be forwarded to Michigan from the U.S. Department of Education, \$418,000 of which may be awarded for new grants, once obligation to continuation grants is met.
