SUBJECT: FY 2010-2011 Comprehensive Community Needs and Resources
Assessment for the Great Start Readiness Program

The FY 2010-2011 Great Start Readiness Program (GSRP) Comprehensive Community Needs and Resources Assessment (CNRA) is available through the Michigan Electronic Grants System (MEGS) website at <https://megs.mde.state.mi.us/megs>.

As the Michigan Department of Education calculates GSRP tentative allocations on submitted CNRAs, school districts and public school academies (PSAs) that do not submit a CNRA on or before the due date may not receive GSRP funding for FY 2010-2011.

School districts/PSAs that qualify and apply under Sections 32d, 39, and 40 of the State School Aid Act may receive funds to operate a GSRP. The FY 2010-2011 GSRP application will also be available through the MEGS. Superintendents and PSA directors will be notified of the application due date.

**The due date for the FY 2010-2011 CNRA to be submitted is
Tuesday, March 30, 2010.**
