ELS Development Services (ELS) offers tutoring for students in grades 3rd through 12th in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Social Studies, and Science. We use technology and a hands-on, problem-based curricular approach as a means of increasing academic achievement for economically disadvantaged students in low performing schools. We tutor in home, schools, community centers, churches, libraries, or on-site at our Detroit location. Tutoring is offered Monday-Thursday, directly before and/or after school, Weekends until 7pm, and during school vacations. All students will receive 32 hours of tutoring. Tutoring sessions will range from 1-3 times per week and last between 1 – 1 ½ hours each session. Student takes a pre-assessment test to determine their individualized learning plan. Most of our tutors are Michigan Certified Teachers, our minimal requirement comply with NCLB requirements, minimum of a high school diploma. We accommodate our Spanish-speaking population.
