How Education Acceleration Explains Their Tutoring Program, in Their Own Words:

Education Acceleration (EA) partners with local school districts and is confident it can accelerate achievement of at-risk students in Grades K-12 in ELA, math and science by 1 grade level. Sessions held 2 times weekly for 2 hours each are customized to meet the needs of students utilizing the research-based Great Source programs. Teacher/student ratio is 1 to 5 with all instructors being highly qualified. Each student is assessed through a comprehensive assessment program that includes diagnostic and ongoing assessments to determine where they are struggling. An individualized learning plan (ILP) is developed that identifies skills and outlines related activities to be addressed to maximize skill acquisition. Students' classroom teachers and parents give input initially and on an ongoing basis. Communication enables EA to ensure that district objectives are addressed in the instructional program. Parents and the school receive a copy of the student's ILP. Skill acquisition and mastery are the goals of our research-based individualized instructional program. After 36 hours of supplemental instruction students are assessed to determine overall growth.
