### Assessment Accommodations - Use of Reader Scripts

The Assessment Accommodation Summary Table, approved by the State Board of Education on September 9, 2009, contains a change in the use of Reader Scripts that was not included in the MEAP Test Administrator Manuals.

Accommodation #20 allows for the use of Reader Scripts for the MEAP mathematics, science and social studies assessments with individual students OR in small groups of no more than 5 students. This is a change from the previous accommodations document.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> paragraph under **Use of Reader Scripts** (page 19) in the MEAP Test Administrator Manuals should read:

*When using reader scripts with appropriate students, the assessment(s) may be administered to individual students or in small groups of no more than five (5) students.*

### Appendix B – After Testing Guidelines

#### **Organizing Answer Documents for Return**

Correction to #1 – used answer documents being returned for scoring do **NOT** need to be separated by class/group number. Item #1 should read:

1. *Separate each school's used answer documents by the following subjects, then by grade (if applicable), and then by form (if applicable).*
  - *Reading – Session 1 (Grade 3 combined answer document/test booklet)*
  - *Reading – Session 2 (Grade 3 combined answer document/test booklet)*
  - *Reading – Sessions 1 and 2 (Grades 4 – 8)*
  - *Mathematics (Grades 3 – 8)*
  - *Science (Grades 5 and 8 only)*
  - *Social Studies (Grades 6 and 9 only)*
  - *Writing (Grades 4 and 7 only)*
