
2012-2013 Career and Technical Education

- ◆ **111,291** or **34 percent** of 11th and 12th grade students were enrolled in a career or technical education program
- ◆ **23,106** students completed a CTE program
- ◆ **76 percent** of CTE graduates surveyed said that they are using the skills they learned in their CTE program in their major area of study or training in college or business or trade school
- ◆ **60 percent** of CTE graduates surveyed reported that they are using the skills they learned in their CTE program in their current job
- ◆ **22** students received 11 Recognition Awards, 3 Excellence Awards, and 8 Merit Awards
- ◆ **2,037** secondary CTE instructors and **83** reimbursed secondary CTE Administrators
