Future Foundations is a certified SES provider in several states. Our program which uses the Wilson Reading System is aligned with Michigan Standards. Our program enables our teachers to maximize effective reading instruction through clear and systematic instruction, bridging between word recognition and comprehension, direct instruction, indirect instruction and comprehension strategies. Our program uses "Achieve" assessments to develop student learning plans with 3 state standards and goals for improvement. To support the development of lesson plans and address the state goals identified on the student learning plan, there is a clear delineation of how all WRS educational materials are aligned with Michigan State Standards and grade expectations. We employ group instruction of ratio of 5:1, which allows for some individualized attention to students. Students attend three times each week for 1.5 hour sessions. All tutors meet Michigan SES qualification Requirements.
