## ***How HTC Tutoring Explains Their Tutoring Program, in Their Own Words:***

H.T.C.'s instructional program incorporates a variety of learning and instructional strategies that differentiate instruction, support multiple instructional models, multiple intelligences, and levels of student achievement. The instructional approach consists of individualized tutoring delivered in 8:1 ratios. Assessment tests are configured to branch up and down "skill trees." This allows educators to identify the lowest and highest levels of mastery of the student. After the assessment test, students are assigned a customized lesson plan containing student-specific activities. The A+nyWhere System has been adopted by hundreds of districts. The data indicates that students who used this program showed significant gains in reading and mathematics on standardized tests. Typically group sessions will be held for in 1 or 2 hour sessions, 1 to 2 days a week. Sessions will be held between the hours of 4:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. Students work at individual computer stations and all supplies are provided.
