

2. Hierarchy in OnlinePQA

OnlinePQA data is a large part of our annual grant evaluation. Results are posted on the grant website: www.michigan.gov/gsrp. The OnlinePQA hierarchy for GSRP:

- State, as grant funder
 - ISD, as grantee
 - Subrecipient (or ISD if directly implementing the program)
 - Subrecipient Site(s)
 - Subrecipient Site-level Classroom(s)

Excluding tribal subrecipients, the GSRP subrecipient name entered into OnlinePQA must be the *licensee*; the legal entity grant funds are being contracted to, as reported on the DHS BCAL license/approval.

The ECC is responsible to monitor entries into the hierarchy. A good cross-check can be made by comparing the OnlinePQA with the MEGS+ Breakdown of Accepted Funds page and also with the classroom pages. They should match!

Not-so-good examples include

- hierarchy by type of subrecipient, e.g., 'Childcare Centers'
- hierarchy by program type, e.g., GSRP/Head Start Blend
- entering the name of a local classroom program in place of the name of the subrecipient
- substituting a GSQ classroom identifier for the name of a subrecipient
- missing subrecipients
- missing classrooms
