I.M.A.G.E. Personal Success Training Institute (IPSTI) has been providing tutoring services in the community for over six years. Students K through 12, are assessed using the Corrective Mathematics and Corrective Reading programs. Staff works with each student and parent to set goals through an individualized learning plan. With this plan, students have the ability to increase their comprehensive, confidence, and grades. During the school year, sessions meet for two hours, twice per week. During the summer months, students meet for two hours, three times a week. On occasion, weekend hours are available to make up missed sessions. Sessions occur in churches, schools, libraries, at the IPSTI office and in student homes, when appropriate. There is a maximum of five students to one highly qualified and trained tutor. All necessary materials, including workbooks and supplies are provided during these sessions.
