The Foundation Institute offers an interactive program designed to excite students about learning. Innovative teaching aids are used to stimulate curiosity and mastery of subjects. A grade level assessment is made upon enrollment. Individual improvement goals and tutorial plans are then established. Student improvement is optimized through the use of Skills Tutor research based modules. Non-intimidating on-line quizzes and tests identify deficiencies and prescribe lesson modules to resolve them. Modules are four weeks and comprised of daily one-on-one interactive instruction, lab exercises, weekly pre and post performance tests. Progress reports and at-home prescriptive assignments are available to parents. Tutorial services are offered in Mathematics, Science and English for students in grades 7-12. All tutors are Certified Teachers/Bachelor degree holders trained in student motivation and cultural sensitivity. Tutoring is offered Monday-Thursday from 3:00 - 6:00pm at the Foundation's lab and public schools.
