SUBJECT: Report on Modifications to the Previously Approved Lapeer Intermediate School District Plan for the Delivery of Special Education Programs and Services

Pursuant to Section 380.1711 of the School Code of 1976, each intermediate school district (ISD) must develop, establish, continually evaluate, and modify its Plan for the Delivery of Special Education Programs and Services (Plan). Approval indicates that intermediate school districts' and local constituent districts' special education programs and services described in the Plan meet standards which are consistent with federal and state requirements. Approval also allows ISDs to receive reimbursement pursuant to the State School Aid Act.

Staff has reviewed, and I have granted approval of the Lapeer Intermediate School District modifications. See Attachment A for a summary of the Lapeer Intermediate School District Plan modifications.

CONTENT AREA	PLAN MODIFICATION
R 340.1832(a) Description of Information Dissemination	The chart listing the contact information for those who can provide information was updated.
R 340.1832(d) Description of Programs Available	R 340.1742: Hearing Impaired programs were removed from the continuum of programs as they will not be offered in the 2012-13 school year. The only two students that are candidates for the programs will be in general education settings in their resident school districts. Therefore, the ISD does not need to offer the programs.
R 340.1832(e) Description of Alternative Programs	R 340.1742: The previous ISD Plan included an increased caseload for programs for students with hearing impairments. Because that program will not be offered, the increased caseload was removed.
